development. This will increase the visibility and impact of the development and may set a precedent for any future development on the site.

The Council was also concerned about car park provision. It has noted problems with parking when large events are held with cars being parked on verges surrounding the development. The amount of car parking space has already been reduced by further building and this application will again reduce space for parking whilst potentially increasing demand for spaces. It would also like to reiterate that all car parking should be effectively screened.
